The EPPL Equivalent Rating is partially influenced by the proximity to O.B., green slopes and the approach length of many of the par-3 holes.

- This is a municipal 9-hole course. Golfers include all skill levels.
- Management promotes the requirements for iron shots and promotes the facility as a great venue for beginners and seniors.
- “If we could only quantify the comparison to a championship course,” said one of the course personnel, “people would realize that it’s not so easy to score well.”

“Based on strategy, shot value, hazards, obstacles and greens, this golf course compares to the stated EPPL yardage and par from the Regular Tees”

- The EPPL Rating used GIS data, including aerial and terrain images, to determine hazard, obstacle and other factors at this facility.
- The final EPPL Equivalent Rating determined that the course plays similar to a 6,194 yard, par 72 course.
- The EPPL Equivalent Rating can now be used in marketing and on scorecards to assist in communicating the unique qualities of the course.



Courses undergoing an EPPL Rating receive an Official Certificate from the Effective Par & Playing Length Council at the completion of the evaluation process.
